Temporary Relief Granted; Deadline to File Motion to Stay Proceedings

On January 17, 2025, South Fork Coal Company, LLC (South Fork) filed an Application for Review and an Application for Temporary Relief from Cessation Order No. C25-111-440-001 issued by the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) on January 13, 2025. To establish a schedule for resolving these matters, I conducted a Prehearing Status Conference on January 21, 2025.

The following individuals attended and participated in the Prehearing Status Conference:

- Christopher B. Power, Esq., counsel for South Fork
- Joseph M. Iole, Esq., counsel for OSMRE
- Brandon Wells, Esq., counsel for OSMRE
- Justin Adams, Esq., counsel for OSMRE

Also present was Lauren Doxey, an attorney-advisor in my office, and Amanda Lamp, a paralegal specialist in my office.

During the Prehearing Status Conference, counsel represented that the parties had reached a settlement concerning South Fork's Application for Review and Application for Temporary Relief and would be submitting appropriate documentation. Following the Prehearing Status Conference, OSMRE filed its Initial Response, which summarized the parties' settlement and attached a signed copy of the Settlement Agreement. The Settlement Agreement states that: (1) the parties have reached a partial settlement of South Fork's Application for Review; and (2) OSMRE does not object to the entry of an order granting temporary relief under the terms and conditions set forth in the parties' Settlement Agreement attached as Exhibit 1.

OSMRE also represented that South Fork would file a motion requesting a stay of these proceedings after entry of an order granting temporary relief. According to the Initial Response, South Fork will be requesting a 120-day stay to allow OSMRE time to make its determination regarding South Fork's Application for a Valid Existing Rights Determination. Although South Fork has not yet submitted its motion, it did file a proposed temporary relief order.

Based on the parties' agreement and a review of the pleadings, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

- 1. South Fork's Application for Temporary Relief is GRANTED pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the parties' Settlement Agreement, attached to OSMRE's Initial Response as Exhibit 1; and
- 2. South Fork must file its motion requesting a stay of these proceedings by no later than **Friday**, **January 24**, **2025**.
